**ORDER GRANTING THE SIXTH OMNIBUS OBJECTION TO AND MOTION TO
REDUCE OR DISALLOW CERTAIN CLAIMS PURSUANT TO 11 U.S.C. § 502(b),
BANKRUPTCY RULES 3001 AND 3007, AND D. ME. LBR 3007-1**

Upon consideration of the Sixth Omnibus Objection to and Motion to Reduce or Disallow Certain Claims Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 502(b), Bankruptcy Rules 3001 and 3007, and D. Me. LBR 3007-1 (the “Sixth Objection”)¹ of the PSC Liquidating Trust (the “PSC Trust”), on behalf of the captioned Reorganized Debtors,² pursuant to which the PCS Trust requested the entry of an order reducing or disallowing the claims listed in Exhibits A through F to the Sixth Objection; and upon consideration of the Sixth Objection, the statements of counsel made at the hearing with respect to the Sixth Objection; and the Court finding that (a) the Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334, the Plan and the Confirmation Order (b) this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2), and (c) notice of the Sixth Objection was due and proper under the circumstances; and it appearing that

the relief requested in the Sixth Objection is in the best interests of the Reorganized Debtors, the PSC Trust, their estates, creditors and beneficiaries; and good and sufficient cause appearing therefore; it is hereby

ORDERED, that the relief requested in the Sixth Objection is granted, and it is further

ORDERED, that each of the Amended Claims listed on Exhibit A to this Order is hereby disallowed and expunged in its entirety; and it is further

ORDERED, that each of the Duplicate Claims listed on Exhibit B to this Order is hereby disallowed and expunged in its entirety; and it is further

ORDERED, that each of the Late Filed Claims on Exhibit C to this Order is hereby disallowed and expunged in its entirety; and it is further

ORDERED, that each of the Disputed Amount Claims on Exhibit D to this Order is hereby reduced to the Modified Claim Amount set forth on Exhibit D; and it is further

ORDERED, that each of the No Liability Claims on Exhibit E to this Order is hereby disallowed and expunged in its entirety; and it is further

ORDERED, that each of the Insufficient Information Claims on Exhibit F to this Order is hereby disallowed and expunged in its entirety; and it is further

ORDERED, that the Reorganized Debtors, the PSC Trust, Trumbull and the Clerk of this Court are authorized to take all actions necessary or appropriate to give effect to this Order; and it is further

ORDERED, that the relief granted herein shall be without prejudice to any party in interest's right to (i) object to any claims, including, without limitation, those that have been continued or withdrawn, on any grounds, (ii) renew any objection, on the grounds set forth in any objection, to any and all objections that have been continued or withdrawn, or (iii) object on

any grounds to any and all other claims filed against the Debtors and their estates in these chapter 11 cases; and it is further

ORDERED, that this Court shall retain jurisdiction to hear and determine all matters arising from and related to the implementation of this Order.
