**ORDER GRANTING EXPEDITED HEARING
AND SHORTENED OBJECTION PERIOD**

This matter came before the Court on the Motion of the Reorganized Debtors and the Liquidating Trustee for an expedited hearing to be held only in the event that an objection is filed during the objection period and a shortened objection period, and after such hearing and notice as is required by Title 11 of the United States Code, the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure and the Local Rules of this Court, the Court finding just cause for the relief sought by the Motion for Expedited Hearing and Shortened Objection Period, it is hereby ORDERED:

That the Motion for Expedited Hearing and Shortened Objection Period is granted. An hearing on the Motion of the Movants for an Order Waiving the Requirements of 11 U.S.C. § 345(b) (the "345 Motion"), shall be set by the Court only in the event that an objection is filed to the 345 Motion prior to July 18, 2005, at 4:00 p.m. EDT. Objections must be filed with the clerk of court and served on (1) Lowenstein Sandler PC, Attn: Paul Kizel, Esq., 65 Livingston Avenue, Roseland, New Jersey 07068; and (2) Preti, Flaherty, Beliveau, Pachios & Haley, LLP, Attn: John P. McVeigh, Esq., One City Center, PO Box 95465, Portland, Maine 04112-9546, on or before July 11, 2005 at 4:00 p.m. EDT.
