**ORDER GRANTING FINAL FEE APPLICATION FOR ALLOWANCE OF  
COMPENSATION AND REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES OF PILLSBURY  
WINTHROP SHAW PITTMAN LLP FOR SERVICES RENDERED AND EXPENSES  
INCURRED AS SPECIAL COUNSEL TO PEGASUS SATELLITE TELEVISION, INC.  
AND CERTAIN OF ITS SUBSIDIARIES AND AFFILIATES  
FROM JUNE 2, 2004 THROUGH MAY 5, 2005**

This matter came before the Court on the Final Fee Application for Allowance of Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses of Pillsbury Winthrop Shaw Pittman LLP (“Pillsbury Winthrop Shaw Pittman”) for Services Rendered and Expenses Incurred as Special Counsel to Pegasus Satellite Television, Inc. and Certain of its Subsidiaries and Affiliates for the period from June 2, 2004 through May 5, 2005 (the “Pillsbury Winthrop Shaw Pittman Final Fee Application”). After proper notice and hearing, the Court having independently reviewed the Pillsbury Winthrop Shaw Pittman Final Fee Application, the Court finding that no responses or objections to the Pillsbury Winthrop Shaw Pittman Final Fee Application were filed by any party-in-interest, it is hereby

ORDERED that, pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 331, the Court grants its final approval for the award of compensation to Pillsbury Winthrop Shaw Pittman LLP in the amount of \$96,164.50, and reimbursement of expenses in the amount of \$5,113.85 for a total of \$101,278.35, for the period of June 2, 2004 through May 5, 2005. This final award of compensation and

reimbursement of expenses is made in accordance with the applicable sections of the Bankruptcy Code, the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure and this Court's local rules.
