Upon consideration of the application (the “Application”) of KPMG LLP (“KPMG”) for an order Approving Final Application of KPMG LLP as Taxation Planning Advisors for Debtors and Debtors-in-Possession for Allowance of Compensation and for Reimbursement of Expenses for the period from September 29, 2004 through May 5, 2005 (the “Compensation Period”) and the Court being satisfied that the relief requested in the Application is in the best interests of the Debtors’ and their estates; and it appearing that due notice of this Application has been given and that no other or further notice be given and sufficient cause appearing therefore, it is

ORDERED that the Application is granted; and it is further
