ORDER ON MOTION FOR RELIEF FROM JUDGMENT

On motion of the Liquidating Trustee, after notice and hearing, and pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 9024, the Court finds that Claim no. 494 was misallocated to the estate of Pegasus Satellite Television, Inc., and that the proper allocation should have been to the estate of Pegasus Satellite Communications, Inc., that the misallocation occurred as the result of a mistake made by the Claims Agent, and that cause exists for ordering relief from the Order on the Debtors' Second Omnibus Objection to Claims, Docket no. 923, to the extent that it applies to Proof of Claim no. 494, submitted by ReGen Capital I, Inc., as Agent for AT&T Corp.. It is therefore

ORDERED that Docket no. 923 is hereby modified as it applies to Claim no. 494, and that Claim no. 494 is allowed in the amount agreed upon by the parties, \$105,089.38, but allocated for payment by the bankruptcy estate of Pegasus Satellite Communications, Inc.
