SCHEDULING ORDER REGARDING
APPLICATION OF GARCEL, INC.
D/B/A THE GREAT AMERICAN GROUP FOR
ALLOWANCE AND PAYMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSE

This matter having come before the Court on the Application for Allowance and Payment of Administrative Expense (the “Application”) filed by Garcel, Inc. d/b/a The Great American Group (“Great American”), and Pegasus Satellite Television, Inc. and its subsidiaries and certain of its affiliates, each a Reorganized Debtor herein (collectively, the “Reorganized Debtors”), and the Liquidating Trustee of The PSC Liquidating Trust (the “Liquidating Trustee”), having filed an objection (the “Objection”) to the Application; and the Court having considered this matter at a hearing held on July 21, 2005; and upon the consent of each of the foregoing parties:

IT IS, HEREBY ORDERED, as follows:

1. All written discovery shall be served no later than August 15, 2005, and all responses to such requests shall be provided no later than September 5, 2005.
2. The parties shall make individuals available for depositions subsequent to September 6, 2005 and prior to October 13, 2005.

3. All parties are to pre-mark and exchange copies of the exhibits they reasonably anticipate offering and exchange a list of all witnesses they intend to present at trial no later than October 20, 2005. Pre-marking shall consist of clearly designating each proposed exhibit in the order of its probable presentation at trial. Plaintiff's proposed exhibits shall be designated by number; defendant's proposed exhibits shall be designated by letter. Copies of proposed exhibits shall be accompanied by a list of the exhibits with a brief identification of each. The witness list shall include a brief summary of the area of testimony each witness will address. The filings may incorporate previously made disclosures.

4. All motions *in limine* shall be filed with the Bankruptcy Court and served on the opposing parties no later than October 24, 2005.

5. A hearing (the "Hearing") shall be conducted on the Application on October 27, 2005 at 1:00 p.m. before the Honorable James B. Haines, Jr., United States Bankruptcy Judge, in his courtroom in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Maine (the "Bankruptcy Court"), 537 Congress Street, 2nd Floor, Portland, Maine 04101. The Hearing shall be continued on October 28, 2005 at 9:00 a.m., if necessary.
