## SCHEDULING ORDER REGARDING OBJECTIONS TO CLAIMS OF **R&R COMMUNICATIONS, PRYOR SALES AND SHAMROCK SYSTEMS**

This matter having come before the Court on certain motions (the "Claims Motions") to reclassify, reduce and disallow certain claims, including (a) claim number 74 in the amount of \$32,672.15 asserted by R&R Communications (the "R&R Claim") (b) claim number 75 in the amount of \$146,983 asserted by Pryor Sales (the "Pryor Sales Claim") and (c) claim number 781 in the amount of \$1825 asserted by Shamrock Systems (the "Shamrock Claim"), and Riverside Claims, LLC ("Riverside"), as assignee of the R&R Claim, the Pryor Sales Claim and the Shamrock Claim (collectively, the "Riverside Claims"), having filed responses to the Claims Motions to the extent they sought to reduce or disallow the Riverdside Claims, and the hearing with respect to the Claims Motions having been adjourned from time to time, and Riverside and the Liquidating Trustee of The PSC Liquidating Trust having agreed to the terms of this scheduling order:

## IT IS, HEREBY ORDERED, as follows:

1. All written discovery requests shall be served no later than November 7, 2005, and all responses to such requests shall be served by no later than December 7, 2005.

2. Depositions shall be conducted between December 7, 2005 and January 9, 2006.

3. On or before February 9, 2006, the parties shall prepare a stipulation of all facts as to which there is no dispute.

4. Riverside shall serve any expert report, if any, on or before November 7, 2005. The Liquidating Trustee shall have 45 days from service of any expert report served by Riverside to serve any expert report it may wish to rely upon or, if Riverside does not timely serve any expert report, the Liquidating Trustee shall have until December 22, 2005 to serve any expert report. The failure to serve an expert report within the time provided herein shall preclude the party who fails to serve such report from relying on any expert testimony or expert evidence.

5. The parties may agree in writing to modify the terms of this scheduling order provided that the date set for the pre-trial conference shall not be adjourned.

6. A pre-trial conference (the "Pre-trial Conference") shall be conducted on February 16, 2006, at 1:00 P.M. before the Honorable James B. Haines, Jr., United States Bankruptcy Judge, in his courtroom in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Maine (the "Bankruptcy Court"), 537 Congress Street, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Portland, Maine 04101. The Court shall set a trial date during the Pre-trial Conference and direct the parties to take such other actions as the Court deems appropriate.
