**AMENDED ORDER GRANTING THE SEVENTH OMNIBUS  
OBJECTION TO AND MOTION TO DISALLOW OR  
RECLASSIFY CERTAIN CLAIMS PURSUANT TO 11 U.S.C.  
§ 502(b), BANKRUPTCY RULE 3007, AND D. ME. LBR 3007-1**

Upon consideration of the Debtors’ Seventh Omnibus Objection to and Motion to Disallow or Reclassify Certain Claims Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 502(b), Bankruptcy Rule 3007, and D. Me. LBR 3007-1 (the ‘Seventh Objection’)<sup>1</sup> of the PSC Liquidating Trust (the “PSC Trust”) on behalf of the Reorganized Debtors,<sup>2</sup> pursuant to which the PSC Trust requested the entry of an order reducing or disallowing the claims listed in Exhibits A through E to the Seventh Objection; and upon consideration of the Seventh Objection, the statements of counsel made at the hearing with respect to the Seventh Objection; and the Court finding that (a) the Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334, (b) this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2), and (c) notice of the Seventh Objection was due and proper

under the circumstances; and it appearing that good and sufficient cause appearing therefore; it is hereby

ORDERED, that the relief requested in the Seventh Objection is granted, and it is further

ORDERED, that each of the No Liability Claims on Exhibit A to this Order is hereby disallowed and expunged in its entirety; and it is further

ORDERED, that each of the Insufficient Information Claims on Exhibit B to this Order is hereby disallowed and expunged in its entirety; and it is further

ORDERED, that the Incorrect Identification Claim listed on Exhibit C to this Order is hereby reclassified as a Class 5A-1 Claim against Pegasus Satellite Communications, Inc.; and it is further

ORDERED, that each of the Late Filed Claims on Exhibit D to this Order is hereby disallowed and expunged in its entirety; and it is further

ORDERED, that the Amended Claim listed on Exhibit E to this order is hereby disallowed and expunged in its entirety; and it is further

ORDERED, that the Reorganized Debtors, the PSC Trust and the Clerk of this Court are authorized to take all actions necessary or appropriate to give effect to this Order; and it is further

ORDERED, that the relief granted herein shall be without prejudice to any party in interest's right to (i) object to any claims, including, without limitation, those that have been continued or withdrawn, on any grounds, (ii) renew any objection, on the grounds set forth in any objection, to any and all objections that have been continued or withdrawn, or (iii) object on any grounds to any and all other claims filed against the Debtors and their estates in these

Chapter 11 cases; and it is further

ORDERED, notwithstanding anything contained herein, none of the claims of the Department of the Treasury set forth in exhibits A-E shall be expunged or reduced and the Seventh Motion is withdrawn without prejudice as to each of such claims.

ORDERED, that this Court shall retain jurisdiction to hear and determine all matters arising from and related to the implementation of this Order.
