**MOTION TO ADMIT GUY S. NEAL, ESQ. FOR ADMISSION
TO APPEAR AND PRACTICE *PRO HAC VICE* ON
BEHALF OF THE DEBTORS AND DEBTORS IN POSSESSION**

Pursuant to Rule 2090-1(a) of the Maine Bankruptcy Rules and Rule 83.1(c) of the Rules of the United States District Court for the District of Maine (the “District Court Local Rules”) and the attached Certificate of Visiting Attorney, Robert J. Keach, Esq. of Bernstein, Shur, Sawyer & Nelson, P.A. (“BSSN”) hereby moves the admission *pro hac vice* of Guy S. Neal, Esq., an attorney from Sidley Austin Brown & Wood LLP (“Sidley”), to represent Pegasus Satellite Television, Inc. and certain of its subsidiaries and affiliates, each a debtor and debtor in possession herein (collectively, the “Debtors”),¹ in the above-captioned chapter 11 cases, and any contested matters, adversary proceedings or other proceedings relating thereto. By Order dated June 24, 2004, the Court has authorized the retention of Sidley as the Debtors’ general bankruptcy counsel in connection with these cases with BSSN as co-counsel. The Certificate of Visiting Attorney attached hereto is incorporated herein by reference.

Neal, Esq., of Sidley, to represent the Debtors in the above-captioned chapter 11 cases, and any contested matters, adversary proceedings or other proceedings relating thereto.
