ORDER ON DEBTORS' EMERGENCY MOTION FOR RELIEF IN RESPECT OF VIOLATIONS OF THE AUTOMATIC STAY BY DIRECTV, INC.

Upon the Emergency Motion for Relief in Respect of Violations of the Automatic Stay by DIRECTV, Inc. of Pegasus Satellite Television, Inc. and certain of its subsidiaries and affiliates, each a debtor and debtor-in-possession herein (collectively, the "Debtors"),¹ for entry of an Order finding DIRECTV, Inc. ("DIRECTV") in violation of the automatic stay imposed by 11 U.S.C. § 362(a), and the Court having reviewed the Motion; and having heard the statements of witnesses and counsel regarding the relief requested in the Motion at a hearing before the Court; and finding that the Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334, that this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2), and that notice of the Motion and the Hearing was due and proper under the circumstances; and it appearing that granting the relief requested in the Motion is in the best interests of the Debtors, their estates, and their creditors; and good and sufficient cause appearing therefore; it is hereby

ORDERED, that the relief requested in this Order is without prejudice to the Debtors rights to request damages relating to the Motion at a future date.
