MOTION FOR EMERGENCY HEARING

NOW COMES Pegasus Satellite Television, Inc., et al. (the “Debtors”)¹, by and through their undersigned counsel, and moves this Court, pursuant to D. Me. LBR 9013-1(j), for an emergency hearing with respect to the Debtors’ Emergency Motion for Relief in Respect of Violations of the Automatic Stay by DIRECTV (the “Stay Violation Motion”). In support of the instant motion, the Debtors state the following:

1. On June 2, 2004, the Debtors filed voluntary petitions for relief under Chapter 11 of the United States Bankruptcy Code, 11 U.S.C. §§ 101-1330 (the “Code”). The Debtors are in possession and control of their respective properties and continue to operate their respective businesses as a debtors-in-possession pursuant to Sections 1107 and 1108 of the Code.

2. The emergent nature of the relief sought by the Stay Violation Motion is clear and unmistakable. Any material delay in obtaining the relief requested in the Stay Violation Motion could immediately and irreparably impair the Debtors’ ability to carry out their respective businesses in the ordinary course, thus affecting prospects for reorganization.

3. Notice of this motion has been provided to (i) the United States Trustee; (ii) the Debtors' primary senior and junior secured creditors, (iii) the indenture trustee(s) for the Debtors' bondholders; (iv) to the Debtors' fifty largest unsecured creditors on a consolidated basis; (v) known counsel to such parties, and (vi) known counsel to DIRECTV by e-mail, facsimile or overnight delivery. Pursuant to Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 2002(m) and 9007, the Debtors request that the Court approve notice and service of the Stay Violation Motion in the manner set forth above as adequate and sufficient under the circumstances.

WHEREFORE, the Debtors respectfully request that the Court enter an order (a) setting an emergency hearing on the Stay Violation Motion for June 7, 2004, at 10:00 a.m., and (b) granting such other relief as the Court may deem just and proper.
