ORDER GRANTING UNOPPOSED MOTION OF THE STEERING
COMMITTEE OF SENIOR SECURED CREDITORS FOR LEAVE
TO FILE A MOTION IN EXCESS OF PAGE LIMIT

Upon consideration of the motion (“Motion”) of the steering committee (the “Steering Committee”) of pre-petition senior secured lenders for leave to file a Motion for an Order Pursuant to Section 506(b) of the Bankruptcy Code for Allowance and Payment of (I) Default Interest and (II) Prepayment Amounts (the “Section 506 Motion”) in excess of the 15-page limit established in paragraph B(1)(e) of this Court’s July 9, 2004 Order Establishing Case Management Procedures and Hearing Schedule (the “Procedural Order”), the Motion is GRANTED and it is hereby ORDERED that the Steering Committee may file the Section 506 Motion of not more than 50 pages in length (exclusive of exhibits).
