ORDER GRANTING UNOPPOSED MOTION OF THE STEERING  
COMMITTEE OF SENIOR SECURED CREDITORS FOR LEAVE  
TO FILE A REPLY IN EXCESS OF PAGE LIMIT

Upon consideration of the motion (“Motion”) of the steering committee (the “Steering Committee”) of pre-petition secured lenders for leave to file a Response to Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors Objection to (I) Motion if the Steering Committee of the Secured Lenders for an Order Pursuant to Section 506(b) of the Bankruptcy Code for Allowance and Payment of (A) Default Interest and (B) Prepayment Amounts, and (II) Motion for an Order Directing Payment of Prepayment Premium, Accrued Default Interest and Interest Thereon Under the Pegasus Junior Term Loan Agreement (the “Response”) in excess of the 5-page limit established in paragraph B(1)(e) of this Court’s July 9, 2004 Order Establishing Case Management Procedures and Hearing Schedule, the Motion is GRANTED and it is hereby ORDERED that the Steering Committee may file a Response of not more than 25 pages in length (exclusive of exhibits).
