**ORDER GRANTING FIRST INTERIM APPLICATION FOR ALLOWANCE OF COMPENSATION
AND REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES OF KEKST AND COMPANY, INCORPORATED FOR
SERVICES RENDERED AND EXPENSES INCURRED AS CORPORATE COMMUNICATIONS
CONSULTANT TO THE DEBTORS FOR THE INTERIM PERIOD
FROM JUNE 2, 2004 THROUGH AUGUST 31, 2004**

This matter came before the Court on the First Interim Application for Allowance of Compensation Reimbursement of Expenses of Kekst and Company, Incorporated for Services Rendered and Expenses Incurred as Corporate Communications Consultant to the Debtors for the First Interim Period From June 2, 2004 through August 31, 2004 (the "Kekst First Interim Fee Application"), after proper notice and hearing, the Court having independently reviewed the Kekst First Interim Fee Application, the Court finding that no responses or objections to the Kekst First Interim Fee Application were filed by any party-in-interest, it is hereby

ORDERED that, pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 331, Kekst and Company, Incorporated ("Kekst") is allowed compensation for services in the amount of \$110,975.00, and reimbursement of expenses in the amount of \$7,776.79 for a total of \$118,751.79, for the period of June 2, 2004 through August 31, 2004. The award of compensation and expenses made hereby is interim only, and Kekst's entitlement to such compensation and expenses is subject to final approval of this Court in accordance with the applicable sections of the Bankruptcy Code, the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure and this Court's local rules.
