**ORDER GRANTING FIRST INTERIM APPLICATION FOR COMPENSATION AND REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES FOR BERNSTEIN, SHUR, SAWYER & NELSON AS CO-COUNSEL TO THE DEBTORS FOR THE PERIOD BEGINNING JUNE 1, 2004 AND ENDING AUGUST 31, 2004**

This matter came before the Court on the First Interim Application for Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses for Bernstein, Shur, Sawyer & Nelson as Co-Counsel to the Debtors for the Period Beginning June 1, 2004 and Ending August 31, 2004 (the “BSSN First Interim Fee Application”), after proper notice and hearing, the Court having independently reviewed the BSSN First Interim Fee Application, the Court finding that no responses or objections to the BSSN First Interim Fee Application were filed by any party-in-interest, it is hereby

ORDERED that, pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 331, Bernstein, Shur, Sawyer & Nelson (“BSSN”) is allowed compensation for services in the amount of \$126,327.00, and reimbursement of expenses in the amount of \$45,195.02 for a total of \$171,522.02, for the period of June 1, 2004 through August 31, 2004. The award of compensation and expenses made hereby is interim only, and BSSN’s entitlement to such compensation and expenses is subject to final approval of this Court in accordance with the applicable sections of the Bankruptcy Code, the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure and this Court’s local rules.
