**ORDER GRANTING MOTION OF GATELINX CORP. TO EXPUNGE AND REPLACE
CERTAIN SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION TO CERTAIN PROOFS
OF CLAIM PURSUANT TO FEDERAL BANKRUPTCY RULE 9018**

On the Motion of Gatelinx Corp. to Expunge and Replace Certain Supporting Documentation to Certain Proofs of Claim Pursuant to Federal Bankruptcy Rule 9018 (the “Motion”), Gatelinx Corp. (“Gatelinx”) having served, either electronically or by First Class U.S. mail, postage prepaid, copies of the Motion and proposed form of order (the “Proposed Order”) granting the same on counsel for the Debtors¹, Robert Checkoway, Esq. of the Office of the United States Trustee, counsel for the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors, and upon each person who filed a notice of appearance and a request for service of papers in the above referenced cases, the Court having considered the Motion and having found good cause to grant the same, it is hereby **ORDERED, DECREED AND ADJUDGED** that:

1. Service, either electronically or by First Class U.S. mail, postage prepaid, of the Motion and the Proposed Order as set forth above was adequate notice to all parties in interest under the circumstances of the cases.

6. Trumbull is authorized and directed to replace the supporting documentation for each POC that is contained on the CDs with the New Documentation submitted by Gatelinx within ten (10) days of the date of this Order.
7. The New Documentation filed with Trumbull by Gatelinx within ten (10) days of the date of this order shall be deemed as filed on the same date as the respective POC was filed with Trumbull.
