**ORDER PURSUANT TO 11 U.S.C. § 1121(d)
EXTENDING DEBTORS' EXCLUSIVE PERIOD IN WHICH TO
SOLICIT ACCEPTANCES TO THE DEBTORS' CHAPTER 11 PLAN**

Upon the motion (the "Motion") dated January 24, 2005, of the debtors and debtors in possession in the above captioned chapter 11 cases (collectively, the "Debtors")¹ for an Order Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 1121(d) Extending Debtors' Exclusive Period in Which to Solicit Acceptances to the Debtors' Chapter 11 Plan with Incorporated Narrative Report Under D.Me. LBR 3016-2; and the Debtors having served the Motion on each of the parties on the All Notices List (as defined therein) in accordance with the Order Establishing Case Management Procedures and Hearing Schedule dated July 9, 2004; and it appearing that no other or further notice is required; and it appearing that this Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334; and it appearing that this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2)(A); and this Court having held a hearing on February 9, 2005 at 11:00 A.M. to consider the Motion and all parties in interest having had an opportunity to be heard with respect

to the Motion at that time; and it appearing that the relief requested in the Motion is in the best interests of the Debtors, their estates and creditors; and after due deliberation thereon, and good and sufficient cause appearing therefor; it is hereby

ORDERED, that the Motion is granted in all respects; and it is further

ORDERED, that all objections to the Motion and entry of this Order or to the relief provided herein that have not been withdrawn, waived, resolved or settled, and all reservations of rights included therein, are hereby denied and overruled on the merits with prejudice; and it is further

ORDERED, that the Exclusive Period² during which time the Debtors will have the exclusive right to solicit acceptances to the Debtors' Chapter 11 Plan is hereby extended to the earlier of the Plan Confirmation Hearing, as such hearing may be adjourned from time to time or April 15, 2005; and it is further

ORDERED, that nothing in this Order shall prejudice the Debtors' right to seek further extensions of the Exclusive Periods from this Court.
