Steve Roman, under penalty of perjury, states:

- 1. I am partner with the firm FirstStrategic, LLC. I am over that age of 18 and am a resident of the State of Arizona. The matters contained in this declaration are of my own knowledge.
- 2. FirstStrategic is a public relations consultant to Jerry Moyes and the Debtors in the Coyotes Hockey Bankruptcy proceedings.
  - 3. In that capacity, I received a call from Rebekah Sanders shortly before 5:00

PM on Friday, July 31, 2009. Ms. Sanders is a reporter for the Arizona Republic newspaper. In that conversation, Ms. Sanders informed me that she had just retrieved a document from the Bankruptcy Court's docket which described some of the proposed financial terms between the City of Glendale and the Reinsdorf Group. I later learned that this document has been referred to as "Appendix A." She was looking for additional information from the Moyes/Debtors' attorneys regarding that document.

- 4. While I was speaking with Ms. Sanders, I called Tom Salerno, whom I understand represents the Debtors in the Coyotes Bankruptcy. With Ms. Sanders on the line, I described to Mr. Salerno the Objection to which Ms. Sanders was referring. Mr. Salerno stated that he did not think it was anything his firm had filed but was likely something filed by Mr. Moyes' personal attorneys, Jennings Strouss.
- 5. I then contacted Peter Sorensen, an attorney I understand represents Mr. Moyes in his individual capacity as a creditor of the Coyotes. I described my call with Ms. Sanders to him. When I described the document that Ms. Sanders had described to me, Mr. Sorensen said, "Steve, I think I've really made a mistake here. I've got to deal with it right now and I'll call you back." I did not immediately break my connection with Mr. Sorensen, though it appeared that he thought I had. Just before I broke the connection, I heard Mr. Sorensen sigh deeply, and I believe he said something like, "Oh, s\*\*t."
- 6. When Mr. Sorensen did not call me back, I called him again. He explained to me that he had made a mistake in filing the document but that he had been able to get in touch with a Bankruptcy Court Clerk who had withdrawn the document from the public record.
- 7. Mr. Sorensen then told me that he needed to contact Mr. Moyes because he knew nothing about the mistake. Mr. Sorensen asked me if I had Jerry Moyes' cell phone number. I provided it to him.
