The National Hockey League ("NHL" or the "League"), through counsel, hereby requests entry of an Order authorizing it to exceed the fifteen page limit of Local Bankruptcy Rule 9013-1(b) relative to the National Hockey League's Motion for a Determination that Debtors' NHL Membership Rights May Not Be Transferred to PSE or an Affiliate Thereof (the "NHL Motion") filed concurrently herewith.

1 The NHL Motion, consisting of twenty two pages, requires a lengthy detailed discussion of the  
2 NHL's Board of Governors' consideration and rejection of PSE's application to transfer ownership of  
3 the Phoenix Coyotes hockey team, the NHL's rules and procedures concerning the requested transfer  
4 and applicable law together with necessary background information. The League does not believe it  
5 can properly provide the Court with the necessary background and information in fifteen pages or less,  
6 especially considering that the League's rejection of PSE is a threshold issue in this case precluding  
7 PSE from being a bidder at the September 11 sale hearing. As such, request is made to exceed the  
8 fifteen page limit set out in Local Bankruptcy Rule 9013-1(b) to permit the filing of the NHL Motion  
9 in its entire length.

10 WHEREFORE, the NHL requests entry of an Order authorizing it to exceed the fifteen page  
11 limit of Local Bankruptcy Rule 9013-1(b) applicable to the NHL Motion filed concurrently herewith,  
12 and granting such other relief as is just in the circumstances.
