The NHL Motion, consisting of twenty two pages, requires a lengthy detailed discussion of the NHL's Board of Governors' consideration and rejection of PSE's application to transfer ownership of the Phoenix Coyotes hockey team, the NHL's rules and procedures concerning the requested transfer and applicable law together with necessary background information. The League does not believe it can properly provide the Court with the necessary background and information in fifteen pages or less, especially considering that the League's rejection of PSE is a threshold issue in this case precluding PSE from being a bidder at the September 11 sale hearing.
