Dear Sir:

The writing of November 18, 2008 over the signature of John A Christy, Attorney, refers.

We sold goods to the subject on February 13, 2008 in the amount of \$2,269.75 less a credit note of \$47.50 against an earlier shipment, resulting in a balance due of \$2,222.25 and which was during the time of their filing Bankruptcy under Chapter 11. It was our understanding that such a sale was protected under the reorganization laws of Vendor priority.

To date we have been unable to realize payment and on September 10, 2008 we wrote to Schreeder, Wheeler & Flint, LLP bespeaking their assistance in effecting this payment. No reply was ever received.

We sold our goods in "good faith" with the belief in the protection under Chapter 11 Bankruptcy Laws of Vendor Priority and as such we fail to see why the Attorneys and others named in the writing of November 18 should receive a preferred payment of some \$400,000.00 over what is due to us. We need to be paid \$2,222.25 first.

The sum of \$53,461.92 owing to us prior to Bankruptcy remains unpaid and we can only be hopeful of receiving a residual payment at the time the accounts are settled.

Enclosed are copies of our April 16, 2008 filing of "Proof of Claim Administrative" with U.S Bankruptcy for \$2,222.25 duly stamped filed May 20, 2008, together with our invoice and statement of the account. Also enclosed is a copy of our September 10, 2008 letter to Schreeder, Wheeler & Flint, LLP, which is self explanatory.

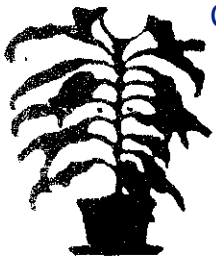
