TO ALL PARTIES IN INTEREST:

1. On February 7, 2002, the above captioned debtors and debtors in possession (the "Debtors") will file with the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Michigan, Southern Division, (the "Bankruptcy Court") the Disclosure Statement for the Joint Consolidated Liquidating Plan of Reorganization Pursuant to Chapter 11 of the United States Bankruptcy Code (the "Disclosure Statement").

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
