On December 2, 2015, came on to be heard the Objection of Acock Consulting, L.L.C. ("ACLLC") to Debtor's Emergency Motion for Authority to Pay or Honor Pre-Petition Obligations to Certain Critical Vendors (docket 14) ("Motion to Pay Vendors") and to Emergency Motion for Authority to Pay Royalty and Working Interest Obligations, Lease Operating Expenses, Jibs, and Trade, And Potential Holders of Statutory Liens (Royalty Motion) (docket 16).

IT IS ORDERED that Debtors are to add Acock Consulting, L.L.C. as a critical vendor with all of the benefits Debtor intends to bestow on its other vendors for the period of November 1 through November 20, 2015. Further, Debtors shall pay ACLLC's lien claim in the sum of \$46,249.02.
