**DECLARATION OF VOTING AGENT REGARDING SOLICITATION AND
TABULATION OF VOTES IN CONNECTION WITH THE
JOINT PLAN OF LIQUIDATION UNDER CHAPTER 11**

Kevin Martin, declares pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746, as follows:

1. I am over eighteen years of age and not a party to the above-captioned cases. I am employed as a Director by BMC Group, Inc. (“BMC”), the voting agent for the above-captioned debtors and debtors in possession (collectively, the “Debtors”) in the chapter 11 cases. My business address is 300 North Continental Blvd., Suite 570, El Segundo, CA 90245.

2. On December 22, 2015, the Court entered its *Order (I) Approving Disclosure Statement and the Form and Manner of Service Related Thereto; (II) Setting Dates for the Objection Deadline and Hearing Relating to Confirmation of the Plan; and (III) Authorizing Related Relief* [Docket No. 271] (the “Disclosure Statement Order”), which approved the *Second Amended Disclosure Statement for Debtors’ Second Amended Joint Plan of Liquidation Pursuant to Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code* [Docket No. 286, Exhibit A] (the “Disclosure Statement”).

3. Under the terms of the *Debtors' Second Amended Joint Plan of Liquidation Pursuant to Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code* [Docket No. 286, Exhibit B] (the "Plan"),² all Claims against and Equity Interests in the Debtors, except General Administrative Claims, Priority Tax Claims, Professional Fee Claims and U.S. Trustee Fees are treated as follows for purposes of voting:

4. In accordance with the solicitation procedures approved by the Court in the Disclosure Statement Order, BMC served solicitation packages containing the following via U.S. Postal Service First Class Mail on December 29, 2015 (the "Solicitation Packages"):

- a) The Plan, Disclosure Statement and Disclosure Statement Order on CD-ROM;

b) The *Notice of Confirmation Hearing* [Docket No. 286, Exhibit I] (the “Confirmation Hearing Notice”);

c) The Class 2 First Lien Claims Ballot, Class 3A/B Beneficial Owner Ballot, Class 3A/B Master Ballot, Class 5 Ace Claims Ballot, Class 6 General Unsecured Trade Claims Ballot and/or Class 7 General Unsecured Non-Trade Claims Ballot, as applicable; and

d) A self-addressed return envelope.

5. The Plan, Disclosure Statement and the Disclosure Statement Order were also posted to the BMC Website at www.bmcgroup.com/raamglobal. The Confirmation Hearing Notice contained information informing parties in interest that such documents are available for viewing or downloading, free of charge, at www.bmcgroup.com/raamglobal.

6. A certificate evidencing service of the Solicitation Packages in accordance with the Disclosure Statement Order was filed with the Court on January 6, 2016 [Docket No. 302].

7. Pursuant to the Disclosure Statement Order, the Court established December 22, 2015 as the Voting Record Date and January 12, 2016, as the Voting Deadline.

8. The Plan, Disclosure Statement and Disclosure Statement Order served as BMC’s guide for the solicitation and tabulation of votes to accept or reject the Plan, and all ballots received were reviewed and tabulated in accordance with the procedures described therein.


13. In tabulating the Ballots, the following Ballots were not counted in determining the acceptance or rejection of the Plan:

- (a) Ballots that partially reject and partially accept the Plan;
- (b) any Ballot that is illegible or contains insufficient information to permit the identification of the claimant;
- (c) Ballots that fail to indicate an acceptance or rejection of the Plan, or that indicate both acceptance and rejection of the Plan;
- (d) Ballots without original signatures, unsigned Ballots, or Ballots that are illegible or contain insufficient information to permit the identification of the holder of interest
- (e) Ballots postmarked prior to the Voting Deadline, but received after the Voting Deadline;
- (f) Facsimile Ballots, or Ballots submitted via email or other electronic transmission, unless the holder receives the consent of the Debtors to submit its Ballot by facsimile, email, or other electronic transmission with such consent to be given in the Debtors' reasonable discretion subject to further Court review; and
- (g) If a holder of a Claim or Equity Interest simultaneously casts inconsistent Ballots.

14. All ballots received by BMC are stored at BMC's El Segundo office, located at 300 N. Continental Boulevard, Suite 570, El Segundo, California 90245 and are available for inspection by the Court or any party in interest.
