We have been provided with a copy of Ms. Mersky's email directed to you of today's date, sent at approximately 11:29 am. We represent a group of individuals and businesses known in the RC Sooner case as the Remy Entities.

As indicated in Ms. Mersky's email message and reflected in the Certification of Counsel filed last week, we have requested a conference with the Court to raise certain objections that we have to the proposed form of Consent Order for Relief from Stay. At hearing on April 19, the Court invited the Remy Entities to seek a conference with the Court in lieu of filing a formal objection if we identified any concerns with its impact on our clients following our review. Also as reflected in Ms. Mersky's email, the parties were unable to reach agreement regarding the objections raised by the Remy Entities. Accordingly, we continue to seek an opportunity to raise our objections with the Court before entry of the Consent Order.
