ORDER GRANTING DEBTORS' MOTION (i) TO QUASH SUBPOENA TO JASON S. BROOKNER TO TESTIFY AT A DEPOSITION IN A BANKRUPTCY CASE AND (ii) FOR PROTECTIVE ORDER

Upon the Motion (i) to Quash Subpoena to Jason S. 1409; and the Court being satisfied that the relief requested in the Motion is appropriate; and it appearing that sufficient notice of the Motion has been given, and that no other or further notice is required; and upon the arguments and representations of counsel at the hearing on the Motion conducted on May 29, 2019 (the "Hearing"); and after due deliberation and good cause appearing therefor, it is

ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Motion is granted for the reasons stated on the record at the Hearing.
2. The Subpoena is hereby quashed.
3. The LP Plaintiffs are precluded from deposing Jason S. Brookner in connection with the Pending Matters.
