The claim I am making is for unused vacation pay. Vacation time accrues and is from October to October . I was eligible to take vacation in October 09. They went by your anniversary date which my hire date was 10/16/2006. Company closed 8/5/2009 and if I figured it correctly I have \$2,168.96 which is for eight days. My annual salary was \$70,500.54 which is \$2,711.54 x 26 pay periods. or 33.89 per hour.

The other amount I am making a claim on is the WARN Act, 60 days of pay due to a notice not being given to employees. The notice was filled by Taylor,Bean after the fact. It was filed 8/20/2009. Sixty days pay equals approximately \$10,844.80, as I am not sure how that would be figured being we were paid by-weekly.
