**NOTICE OF FOURTH MODIFICATION OF STIPULATION BETWEEN  
DEBTOR TAYLOR, BEAN & WHITAKER MORTGAGE CORP.  
AND FEDERAL DEPOSIT INSURANCE CORPORATION,  
AS RECEIVER FOR COLONIAL BANK**

The Debtor and the FDIC-Receiver of Colonial Bank, Montgomery, Alabama (“FDIC-Receiver”), by and through their undersigned counsel, give notice that the Stipulation Between Debtor Taylor, Bean & Whitaker Mortgage Corp. and Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, as Receiver for Colonial Bank (“Stipulation”) is being modified to change the reporting schedule. The last sentence of Paragraph 9 of the Stipulation regarding reporting (as previously modified) is amended to read as follows:

“From time to time, during the course of the reconciliation processes, the Debtor shall file interim status reports with the Court. The next such report shall be filed on or about July 1, 2010.”

Because of the amount of information involved, the FDIC-Receiver requires additional time to review the Debtor’s work prior to the report being filed. Debtor and the FDIC-Receiver thus believe that this revision to the reporting schedule is warranted. With this revision, the Debtor and the FDIC-Receiver expect that the report filed on July 1, 2010 will be the final report regarding the Servicing Reconciliation and the Asset Reconciliation, and that the Debtor will be

able to present the findings in the report to the Court during the hearing scheduled for July 2, 2010. The Debtor and the FDIC-Receiver do not anticipate that further extensions of the filing date will be required.
