
Dear Judge Funk:

On behalf of my client BNP Paribas (“BNPP”), I submit this letter brief in connection with the dispute that has arisen between the Federal Home Loan Mortgage Corporation (“Freddie Mac”) and Bank of America, N.A. (“BoA”) with respect to BoA’s access to documents Freddie Mac has been ordered by this Court to produce. As the resolution of this dispute will affect the rights of BNPP with respect to those same documents, I write to join in the letter brief submitted on August 13, 2010 by Michael Tessitore on behalf of BoA (the “BoA Letter Brief”). BNPP’s joinder further responds to paragraph 20 of Freddie Mac’s August 13, 2010 Brief in Support of Its Request for Order Clarifying Restrictions on Bank of America’s Use and Disclosure of Its Confidential Information, which states that BNPP has not expressed any “contrary” interpretation of the NDA or sought to join BoA in contesting Freddie Mac’s interpretation of the NDA.

For the reasons set forth in the BoA Letter Brief, BNPP respectfully joins BoA’s request for entry of an order clarifying that the NDA and July 7 Order shall not be construed in any manner that would preclude or otherwise impair the ability of BNPP’s outside professionals who are bound by the terms of the NDA to render advice to BNPP.
