
**ORDER APPROVING FOURTH INTERIM
APPLICATION AND ALLOWING COMPENSATION AND
EXPENSES TO STICHTER, RIEDEL, BLAIN & PROSSER, P.A.
AS ATTORNEYS FOR DEBTORS AND DEBTORS IN POSSESSION**

THIS CASE came before the Court on March 4, 2011, for hearing on the *Fourth Interim Application of Stichter, Riedel, Blain & Prosser, P.A. for Allowance and Payment of Compensation for Services Rendered and Reimbursement of Expenses Incurred as Attorneys for Debtors and Debtors in Possession* (Doc. No. 2538) (the "**Application**"). Stichter, Riedel, Blain & Prosser, P.A. ("**Stichter Riedel**"), as attorneys for the Debtors and Debtors in Possession, requests allowance of compensation for services rendered and reimbursement for expenses incurred for the time period September 1, 2010, through December 31, 2010. No creditor or other party in interest objected to the services, amounts of time, compensation amounts, reimbursement, approval of the Application, or payment of the requested amounts. For the reasons stated orally and recorded in open court that shall constitute the decision of the Court, it is

ORDERED:

1. The Application is approved.
2. Stichter Riedel is allowed compensation for services rendered in the amount of \$203,320.00 and reimbursement for expenses incurred in the amount of \$8,619.68, for a total allowance of \$211,939.68, for the time period covered by the Application.
3. After applying \$171,275.68 in monthly invoice amounts paid prior to the filing of the Application, all of which were amounts paid and applied in accordance with this Court's *Order Establishing Procedures for Payments to Professionals of Interim Compensation for Services and Reimbursement of Expenses* (Doc. No. 620), Stichter Riedel is allowed a net administrative expense claim in the amount of \$40,664.00, which amount the Debtors are authorized and directed to pay immediately upon entry of this Order.
