**ORDER DENYING AMERICAN HOME MORTGAGE
SERVICING, INC.'S MOTION TO LIFT, MODIFY OR
ANNUL AUTOMATIC STAY OR FOR ADEQUATE PROTECTION**

THIS CASE came on for hearing on July 13, 2011, upon the Motion to Lift, Modify or Annul Automatic Stay or for Adequate Protection (the "**Motion**")¹ (Docket No. 3262) filed by American Home Mortgage Servicing, Inc., as servicing agent for U.S. Bank National Association, as Trustee For TBW Mortgage-Backed Trust 2006-6, Mortgage Pass-Through Certificates, Series 2006-6 (the "**Movant**").
