
ORDER SUSTAINING OBJECTION TO CLAIM OF ROBERT P. DUPREY, JR.

This case came before the Court on September 16, 2011 at 10:00 a.m. upon the *Debtors'* *Omnibus Objection #4: Claims Improperly Filed as Secured and/or Priority* (D.E. No. 2240) (the "Objection") objecting to the claim of Robert P. Duprey, Jr. and filed under negative notice in accordance with Local Rules 2002-4 and 3007-1. Mr. Duprey's claim (Claim No. 3272 (the "Claim")) was filed as a secured claim in the amount of \$1,073.50 plus postpetition interest of \$1,989.32. The Court, having considered the Objection and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, agrees with the Debtors that the Claim is not secured and that Mr. Duprey received \$1,073.50, the entire amount of the Claim but for postpetition interest. As an unsecured claim is not generally entitled to postpetition interest, it is hereby

ORDERED as follows:

✶ The Objection as to the balance of the Claim (\$1,989.32) is hereby sustained and the Claim as to that amount is disallowed.
