**ORDER GRANTING BANK OF AMERICA'S EX PARTE AGREED MOTION FOR
EXTENSION OF TIME TO RESPOND TO OBJECTION TO CLAIM**

This Case is before the Court, without a hearing, on the Second *Ex Parte* Agreed Motion for Extension of Time to Respond to Objection to Claim (the "Second Agreed Motion") filed by Bank of America, National Association ("Bank of America"), as successor in interest through merger to LaSalle Bank, National Association and LaSalle Global Trust Services, on its own behalf and in its capacity as Collateral Agent, Indenture Trustee, Depository, Custodian and in other capacities with respect to Ocala Funding, LLC, on June 8, 2012 [DE ⁵⁴⁵⁵___]. By the Second Agreed Motion, Bank of America seeks a second sixty (60) day extension through and including August 7, 2012 to respond to the Objection to the Administrative Expense Portion of Claim No. 3063 Filed by Bank of America, N.A. as Indenture Trustee, Collateral Agent, Custodian and Depository Agent for Ocala Funding, LLC (the "Claim Objection") filed by Neil F. Luria, Plan Trustee of the Taylor, Bean & Whitaker Plan Trust, on March 8, 2012 [DE 5007].

Upon review of the Second Agreed Motion, all the proceedings in this Case, and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor, the Court finds it appropriate to grant the Second Agreed Motion and the extension requested therein without a hearing. Accordingly,

it is

ORDERED:

1. The Second Agreed Motion is GRANTED.
2. The deadline for Bank of America to respond to the Claim Objection is extended through and including August 7, 2012 pursuant to Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 9006(b).
3. The extension granted herein is without prejudice to Bank of America requesting additional time to respond to the Claim Objection should it become necessary and without prejudice to any party opposing such request.
