FINAL EVIDENTIARY HEARING SCHEDULED FOR AUGUST 23, 2012**


THIS CASE came before the Court for consideration of the Agreed Motion to Continue Final Evidentiary Hearing Scheduled for August 23, 2012 (the “**Motion**”) (Doc. No. 5813) with respect to the Debtors’ Omnibus Objection #1: Claims Improperly Filed as Secured, as it relates to the claims of LLP Mortgage, Ltd. and LNV Corporation, (Doc. No. 2237) and LLP Mortgage, Ltd.’s and LNV Corporation’s Response to Debtors’ Omnibus Objection #1: Claims Improperly Filed as Secured (Doc. No. 2861). The parties have agreed to a continuance of the August 23, 2012, final evidentiary hearing (the “**Hearing**”) for at least thirty (30) days to facilitate settlement discussions.
