ORDER GRANTING AGREED *EX PARTE* MOTION TO CONTINUE AUGUST 16, 2012 HEARING ON (I) MOTION FOR TRADE CREDITOR CLASSIFICATION FILED BY INTEGRITY FIELD SERVICES, INC., (II) APPLICATION FOR PAYMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSES OF INTEGRITY FIELD SERVICES, INC., AND (III) OBJECTION TO CLAIM NO. 1593 FILED BY INTEGRITY FIELD SERVICES, INC.

THIS MATTER came before the Court, without a hearing, upon Integrity Field Services, Inc. and the Plan Trustee's *Agreed Ex Parte Motion to Continue August 16, 2012 Hearing on (I) Motion for Trade Creditor Classification Filed by Integrity Field Services, Inc., (II) Application for Payment of Administrative Expenses of Integrity Field Services, Inc., and (III) Objection to Claim No. 1593 Filed by Integrity Field Services, Inc.* (D.E. No. 5818) (the "Motion"). The Court finding that the relief requested by the Motion is reasonable and having been advised that the parties are in agreement as to the form of this Order, does

ORDER:


1. The Motion is GRANTED.

2. Matters relating to Integrity Field Services, Inc. that were set for hearing on August 16, 2012 are continued by at least ninety days to JANUARY 17, 2012³ AT 10:00 A.M.

3. The Plan Trustee's deadline to respond to Integrity's Requests for Production is continued until mediation in related Adversary Proceeding Case No. 3:11-ap-00881-JAF is completed.

4. Integrity Field Services, Inc. is prohibited from serving further discovery requests on the Plan Trust until the mediation of the Adversary Proceeding Case No. 3:11-ap-00881-JAF is completed.
