that certain piece or parcel of land situated in the Town of Bolton, County of Tolland, and State of Connecticut, bounded and described as follows:

Commencing at a point in the easterly line of the Hartford-Willimantic Road, known as Route No. 6, said point being six hundred seventy-four (674) feet southerly from the southwesterly corner of land now or formerly of the Estate of Pietro Traverso as measured along (arc distance) the easterly line of said Hartford-Willimantic Road; the line runs thence easterly by interior angle of 90° a distance of seven hundred and nine tenths (700.9) feet to a point; the line runs thence southerly by interior angle of 87°38'40", a distance of two hundred fifty-nine and five tenths (259.5) feet to a point; the line runs thence westerly by interior angle of 98°13'40", a distance of six hundred sixty-seven and six tenths (667.6) feet to the easterly line of said Hartford-Willimantic Road; the line runs thence northerly along said easterly line of said road, a distance of three hundred twenty-three and seventy-three one hundredths (323.73) feet (arc distance) to the place or point of beginning.
