ORDERED that:

1. The Motion is granted upon the terms and conditions set forth herein.

2. The automatic stay is lifted effective as of the date of the entry this Order for the

sole purpose of allowing the Movant to pursue in rem relief with respect to the property located

at 3 Pine Street, Webster, Massachusetts 01570 which bears the following legal description:
