PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on December 20, 2002, the TWA Inc. Post Confirmation Estate (the "Estate") filed its Fifth Omnibus Objection to Claims (the "Fifth Omnibus Objection") with the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that the following entities will receive a copy of the Fifth Omnibus Objection: (i) those who have filed claims that are affected by the Fifth Omnibus Objection; (ii) the United States Trustee; and (iii) all parties who have requested notice pursuant to Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 2002.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE THAT:

1. A hearing on the Fifth Omnibus Objection will be held before the Honorable Peter J. Walsh, United States Bankruptcy Court, 824 N. Market Street, 6th Floor, Wilmington, Delaware on **February 7, 2003 at 11:00 a.m.** (the "Claims Hearing");

2. Any party whose claim is subject to the Fifth Omnibus Objection should read this Notice and the accompanying papers carefully and discuss them with their attorney. All such parties should be aware that their claims may be reduced, modified, or eliminated by virtue of the relief sought in the Fifth Omnibus Objection.

3. Any party wishing to oppose the relief requested in the Fifth Omnibus Objection must file a written response with the Clerk of the Bankruptcy Court at 824 N. Market Street, Wilmington, Delaware 19801, and serve a copy of the response upon **Kirkland & Ellis, 200 East Randolph Drive, Suite 6500, Chicago, Illinois 60601, Attn: Alexis N. Gabay, and Pachulski, Stang, Ziehl, Young & Jones, P.C., 919 North Market Street, 16th Floor, P.O. Box 8705, Wilmington, Delaware 19899-8705 (Courier 19801), Attn: Bruce Grohsgal, so as to be received on or before January 22, 2003 at 4:00 p.m. prevailing Eastern time.** Only those responses timely filed with the Court and received by the above in accordance with this Notice will be considered by the Court.

4. Any response filed with the Court must contain, at a minimum, the following:

- (a) A caption setting forth the name of the Court, the name of the Debtor, the case number and the title of the Objection to which the response is directed;
- (b) The name of the claimant and a description of the basis for the amount of the claim;
- (c) The specific factual basis and supporting legal argument upon which the party will rely in opposing the Fifth Omnibus Objection;
- (d) Any supporting documentation, to the extent it was not included with the proof of claim previously filed with the Clerk or the Estate's claims agent, Bankruptcy Services, LLC, upon which the party will rely to support the basis for and amounts asserted in the proof of claim;
- (e) The address to which the Estate must serve any reply to the response; and
- (f) The name, address, and telephone number of the person (you or your legal representative) possessing ultimate authority to reconcile, settle, or otherwise resolve the Objection on behalf of the claimant.

5. The Estate will endeavor to reach a consensual resolution with any party who files a timely response in accordance with the above-referenced procedures. If no consensual agreement is reached, the Estate may request the Court to conduct a hearing with respect to the Estate's objection to the applicable claim and the related response.

6. Any party's failure to timely file a response to the Fifth Omnibus Objection shall be deemed that party's waiver of its right to respond to the Fifth Omnibus Objection and consent to the relief requested in the Fifth Omnibus Objection with respect to that party's claim.

7. The Estate reserves the right to seek an adjournment of the Claims Hearing with respect to one or more of the Objections contained in the Fifth Omnibus Objection as stated in open court.

8. The Estate has sought leave to file and serve a reply to a claimant's response so that it is received by the claimant (or the claimant's counsel, if represented) no later than forty-eight hours before the Claims Hearing.

9. The Estate reserves the right to object in the future to any of the claims set forth in the Fifth Omnibus Objection or the Exhibits attached thereto on any grounds. Separate notice and hearing will be scheduled for any such objection.

10. Any party may obtain a copy of the Fifth Omnibus Objection with all Exhibits by requesting the same from the Estate's information agent, Bankruptcy Management Corporation ("BMC"), at (888) 909-0100 or by logging onto the BMC website at <http://www.bmccorp.net/twa/>.
