**ORDER APPROVING EMERGENCY MOTION FOR ORDER (A) APPROVING NOTICE OF CASE COMMENCEMENT; (B) APPROVING FILING OF CONSOLIDATED LIST OF 40 LARGEST UNSECURED CREDITORS; (C) ESTABLISHING BAR DATES; AND (D) APPROVING SERVICE BY ELECTRONIC MEANS**

**ORDERED** that all entities other than governmental units (including, without limitation, individuals, partnerships, corporations, joint ventures and trusts) that assert any of the claims described below (collectively, the "Qualifying Claims") must file a proof of claim in accordance with the procedures described herein by **July 28, 2010** (the "General Bar Date") for all claims against the Debtors that arose or are deemed to have arisen prior to the Petition Date. It is further

**ORDERED** that all governmental units that assert Qualifying Claims must file a proof of claim in accordance with the procedures described herein by **November 17, 2010**. It is further

**ORDERED** that, except as set forth below, the General Bar Date and the Government Bar Date, as applicable, apply to all types of claims against Debtors that arose prior to the Petition Date, including secured claims, unsecured priority claims entitled to priority under §§ 507(a)(4), (5) and (8) and 503(b)(9) of the Bankruptcy Code and unsecured nonpriority claims. The filing of a proof of claim form shall be deemed to satisfy the procedural requirements for the assertion of administrative priority claims under § 503(b)(9) of the Bankruptcy Code. All other administrative claims under § 503(b) of the Bankruptcy Code shall be made by separate requests for payment in accordance with § 503(a) of the Bankruptcy Code and shall not be deemed proper if made by proof of claim. It is further

**ORDERED** that proofs of claim must specify by name and case number the Debtor against which the claim is filed. If the holder asserts a claim against more than one Debtor or has

6. Current officers and directors of the Debtors who assert claims solely for indemnification and/or contribution arising as a result of such officers' or directors' prepetition or postpetition services to the Debtors.

**ORDERED** that service of pleadings will be by electronic means unless persons who must receive notice are not listed on the Notice of Electronic Filing or may not be served electronically pursuant to the General Order or Bankruptcy Rules (the "Non-Electronic Service Persons"). It is further

**ORDERED** that subject to Bankruptcy Rule 9006 and pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 3003(c)(2), any entity that is required to file a proof of claim in these chapter 11 cases pursuant to the Bankruptcy Code, the Bankruptcy Rules or this Order with respect to a particular claim against a Debtor, but that fails to properly do so by the applicable Bar Date, shall be forever barred, estopped and enjoined from: (a) asserting any claim against the Debtors that the entity has that (i) is an amount that exceeds the amount, if any, that is identified in the Schedules on behalf of such entity as undisputed, noncontingent and liquidated or (ii) is of a different nature or a different classification than any claim identified in the Schedules on behalf of such entity (any such claim under subparagraph (a) of this paragraph being referred to herein as an "Unscheduled Claim"); or (b) voting upon, or receiving distributions under any Plan in these Cases in respect of an Unscheduled Claim.
