INTERIM ORDER APPROVING APPLICATION TO EMPLOY BAKER STERCHI COWDEN & RICE , L.L.C. AS SPECIAL COUNSEL

UPON CONSIDERATION of the Application to Employ Baker Sterchi Cowden & Rice, L.L.C. as Special Counsel (the "Application") [Docket No. 90]¹ the Court is satisfied that, based upon the affidavit submitted pursuant to Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 2014 in support thereof, Baker Sterchi (1) represents no interest adverse to the Debtors or their estates that would disqualify them from employment

ORDERED that the *Debtors are authorized to* employ *nunc pro tunc* Baker Sterchi, as special counsel in the Cases, *as provided in this order*. It is further

ORDERED that no later than five (5) business days after the date of this Order, Debtor's counsel is directed to serve a copy of the Order on all parties listed below.
