SIXTH NOTICE OF ADDITIONAL CARRIERS

On December 3, 2004, the Court entered its Stipulation and Consent Order by and Among Certain Carriers and the Debtors Regarding Adequate Assurance/Adequate Protection of Future Payments [Docket No. 451] (the "Stipulation")

Paragraph 19 of the Stipulation provides,

Procedure for Additional Carriers. A carrier or provider not party to this Stipulation (an "Additional Carrier") may become subject to this Stipulation's terms by agreeing to perform under, and acknowledging the validity of, this Stipulation with respect to the Additional Carrier. Any document evidencing the Additional Carrier's agreement to and acknowledgment of this Stipulation (which is signed by the Additional Carrier and the Debtors) (the "Additional Carrier Agreement") shall be filed with the Bankruptcy Court and served on the parties listed on the master service list established in these Cases. The Additional Carrier Agreement shall be effective as of the date on which it is filed with the Bankruptcy Court, and no further Bankruptcy Court approval of it shall be required. All time periods beginning on the date of entry of the Stipulation shall begin to run from the date the Additional Carrier Agreement is filed with the Bankruptcy Court.

Stipulation at 17-18.

The parties identified in column A of the table attached hereto as **Exhibit A** (the “Supplemental Table”) are Additional Carriers that agree to become subject to the Stipulation’s terms. The Supplemental Table shall supplement the Table (as defined in the Stipulation and as modified by the First Notice of Additional Carriers [Docket No. 585], the Second Notice of Additional Carriers [Docket No. 701], Third Notice of Additional Carriers [Docket No. 798], Fourth Notice of Additional Carriers [Docket No. 855], and the Fifth Notice of Additional Carriers [Docket No. 1029]).
