ORDERED that the Debtors' exclusive period for filing a plan shall be and hereby is extended through and including the hearing currently scheduled for October 11, 2005 at 1:30 p.m. It is further

ORDERED that this Order is without prejudice to (i) the Debtors' right to seek further extensions of such Exclusive Periods and (ii) any rights or remedies which the Official Committee may otherwise be entitled to assert.
