ORDER AUTHORIZING REJECTION OF NONRESIDENTIAL REAL PROPERTY LEASE (60 HUDSON STREET, NEW YORK, NEW YORK)

On November 1, 2005, the Court considered the Motion to Authorize Rejection of Nonresidential Real Property Lease and Brief in Support (60 Hudson Street, New York, New York) [Docket No. 1927] (the "Motion")¹ filed by the above-referenced debtors (the "Debtors"). ORDERED that the Landlord shall file a proof of claim by December 30, 2005 if it asserts any claim(s) against any of the Debtors or their estates on account of or arising from the rejection of the Agreement, and in the absence of the filing of such a proof of claim, any such claim shall be forever waived and discharged
