**ORDER APPROVING APPLICATION OF BICKEL & BREWER FOR
ALLOWANCE OF FEES AND EXPENSES AS CO-COUNSEL FOR THE OFFICIAL
COMMITTEE OF EXCEL INDEPENDENT REPRESENTATIVES FOR
THE PERIOD OF JULY 1, 2005 THROUGH OCTOBER 31, 2005**

On December 13, 2005, the Court considered the Application of Bickel & Brewer for Allowance of Fees and Expenses as Co-Counsel for the Official Committee of Excel Independent Representatives for the Period of July 1, 2005 through October 31, 2005 [Docket No. 2090] (the “Fee Application”). Based upon the Fee Application and the record made at the hearing thereon, the Court finds that the fees and expenses requested by Bickel & Brewer are reasonable, actual, and necessary and that good cause exists for the payment of Bickel & Brewer’s fees and expenses. The Court further finds that notice of the Fee Application was proper and that no other or further notice is necessary. Therefore, it is

ORDER APPROVING APPLICATION OF BICKEL & BREWER FOR ALLOWANCE OF FEES AND EXPENSES AS CO-COUNSEL FOR THE OFFICIAL COMMITTEE OF EXCEL INDEPENDENT REPRESENTATIVES FOR THE PERIOD OF JULY 1, 2005 THROUGH OCTOBER 31, 2005

ORDERED that the Fee Application is **APPROVED** to the extent set forth herein. It is further

ORDERED that Bickel & Brewer shall be allowed interim compensation of fees in the amount of \$2,228.50 (the "Fees") and reimbursement of expenses in the amount of \$2,815.28 (the "Expenses") for the period from July 1, 2005 through October 31, 2005. It is further

ORDERED that the Debtors promptly shall pay Bickel & Brewer the Fees and Expenses requested in the Fee Application in the aggregate amount of approximately \$5,043.78, less amounts previously paid to Bickel & Brewer by the Debtors with respect thereto.
