ORDER APPROVING THIRD INTERIM FEE APPLICATION OF HUGHES & LUCE LLP, SPECIAL COUNSEL TO THE DEBTORS, FOR ALLOWANCE OF COMPENSATION AND REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES FOR THE PERIOD JULY 1, 2005 THROUGH OCTOBER 31, 2005

On December 19, 2005, the Court considered the Third Interim Fee Application of Hughes & Luce LLP ("H&L"), Special Counsel to the Debtors, For Allowance of Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses [Docket No. 2119], for the period July 1, 2005 through October 31, 2005 (the "Fee Application"). The Court finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter, and further finds that this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2)(A) and (b)(2)(O). Based upon the Fee Application and the record made at the hearing, the Court finds that the fees and expenses requested by H&L are reasonable, actual, and necessary and that good cause exists

for the allowance and payment of H&L's fees and expenses as set forth in the Fee Application.

The Court further finds that notice of the Fee Application was proper and that no other or further

notice is necessary. Therefore, it is

ORDERED that the Fee Application is APPROVED. It is further

ORDERED that H&L shall be allowed interim compensation of fees in the amount of

\$205,669.00 (the "Fees") and reimbursement of expenses in the amount of \$27,723.22 for the

period of July 1, 2005 through October 31, 2005. It is further

ORDERED that the Debtors shall promptly pay to H&L the Fees and Expenses that were

not previously paid by the Debtors pursuant to this Court's Amended Order Establishing

Procedures for Monthly and Interim Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses for Case

Professionals [Docket No. 118], which amount is, in the aggregate, \$41,133.90.
