If you mail your response to the Court for filing, you must mail it early enough so the Court will **receive** it on or before the Response Deadline. If you electronically file your response, it must be electronically filed on or before the Response Deadline.

- Attend the hearing scheduled to be held on **March 27, 2007 at 2:30 p.m., Eastern Time**, in the Judge’s usual courtroom at the address of the United States Bankruptcy Court stated above.

If you or your attorney do not take these steps, the Court may decide that you do not oppose the relief sought in the Applications and may enter an order granting that relief without conducting a hearing.
