- Attend the hearing scheduled to be held on **July 24, 2007 at 1:30 p.m., Eastern Time**, in the Judge’s usual courtroom at the address of the United States Bankruptcy Court stated above.

If you or your attorney do not take these steps, the Court may decide that you do not oppose the relief sought in the Motions and may enter an order granting that relief without conducting a hearing.
