

- ii. Claims set forth in Exhibit I to the Second Omnibus Claims Objection – Various former employees at the Middlefield, Ohio plant. The CEP Liquidating Trust and Unite AFL-CIO, CLC Local 1902 have agreed in principal on a resolution of these claims and are currently working toward documentation of their agreement. The CEP Liquidating Trust will request this matter not go forward to permit the parties additional time to facilitate documentation, consent by the former employees and payment of the claims in accordance with the parties' agreement.

2. Docket 818 – Objection to Claims of Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation [Claim Nos. 646 & 647]:

- i. The CEP Liquidating Trust and the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation have agreed in principal on a resolution of these claims and are currently working toward approvals and documentation of their agreement. The CEP Liquidating Trust will request this matter not go forward to permit the parties additional time to facilitate documentation, consent by the former employees and payment of the claims in accordance with the parties' agreement.
