FEE AUDITOR'S FINAL REPORT REGARDING INTERIM FEE APPLICATION OF MORRIS, NICHOLS, ARSHT & TUNNELL LLP FOR THE SIXTH INTERIM PERIOD

This is the final report of Warren H. Smith & Associates, P.C., acting in its capacity as fee auditor in the above-captioned bankruptcy proceedings, regarding the <u>Fee Application of Morris</u>, <u>Nichols, Arsht & Tunnell LLP for the Sixth Interim Period</u> (the "Application").

BACKGROUND

- 1. Morris, Nichols, Arsht & Tunnell LLP ("MNAT") was retained as counsel to the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors. In the Application, MNAT seeks approval of fees totaling \$109,518.50 and costs totaling \$5,068.00 for its services from January 1, 2008 through March 31, 2008 (the "Application Period").
- 2. In conducting this audit and reaching the conclusions and recommendations contained herein, we reviewed in detail the Application in its entirety, including each of the time and expense entries included in the exhibits to the Application, for compliance with Local Rule 2016-2 of the Local Rules of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware, Amended Effective February 1, 2008, and the United States Trustee Guidelines for Reviewing Applications for Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses Filed Under 11 U.S.C. 330, Issued January 30, 1996 (the "Guidelines"), as well as for consistency with precedent established in the United States

Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware, the United States District Court for the District of Delaware, and the Third Circuit Court of Appeals. We served on MNAT an initial report based on our review, and received a response from MNAT, portions of which response are quoted herein.

DISCUSSION

3. We noted that professionals Tate and Urban (each at the rate of \$120 per hour) spent 4.20 hours and \$504.00 performing similar, if not the same, tasks on the same day. The time entries are as follows:

We asked MNAT to further explain these time entries and it responded as follows:

In this paragraph you note that professionals Tate, Bryant and Urban spent 4.20 hours and \$504.00 performing similar, if not the same, tasks on the same day.

MNAT agrees to reduce this amount by \$252.00, which is half of the total request.

We appreciate MNAT's response and thus, recommend a reduction in the amount of \$252.00 in fees.

4. We noted two hotel charges which are insufficient in detail and may be viewed as excessive:

We asked MNAT to provide further explanation regarding these hotel charges and it responded as follows:

The first entry, 629807, was for hotel accommodations at The Waldorf Astoria in New York for one night for William H. Sudell in connection with his attendance at the meeting of the creditors' committee and bondholders. The room charge was \$599.00 plus tax. The second entry, 629982, was for hotel accommodations at The Waldorf Astoria In New York for one night for Derek C. Abbott in connection with his attendance at the meeting of the creditors' committee and bondholders. The room charge was \$599.00 plus tax.

We appreciate MNAT's response. Further, we note that The Waldorf Astoria hotel in New York is rated four stars on Expedia's website (pursuant to our July 22, 2008 letter to the Court regarding revised hotel rates). Thus, we have no objection to these expenses.

CONCLUSION

5. Thus we recommend approval of fees totaling \$109,266.50 (\$109,518.50 minus \$252.00) and expenses in the amount of \$5,068.00 for MNAT's services from January 1, 2008 through March 31, 2008.
