NOTICE OF DEBTORS' OBJECTION TO PROOF OF CLAIM NUMBER 1

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the above-captioned debtors and debtors in possession (collectively, the "Debtors") filed their Objection to Proof of Claim Number 1 (the "Objection") with the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware. The Debtors seek to disallow and expunge such claim.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that a hearing on the Objection (the "Hearing") will be held before the Honorable Kevin J. Carey, Chief United States Bankruptcy Judge, in the United States Bankruptcy Court (the "Bankruptcy Court"), 824 Market Street, 5th Floor, Courtroom No. 5, Wilmington, Delaware 19801, on **December 9, 2008 at 1:30 p.m. (ET).**

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that responses ("Responses") to the Objection, if any, must be made in writing, filed with the Bankruptcy Court and served upon the undersigned counsel to the Debtors so as to be **RECEIVED NO LATER THAN 4:00 P.M. (EASTERN TIME) ON DECEMBER 2, 2008.**

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that every response to an Objection must contain at a minimum the following:

- (a) a caption setting forth the name of the Bankruptcy Court, the case number and the title of the Objection to which the response is directed;
- (b) the name of the claimant and description of the basis for the amount of the claim;
- (c) a concise statement setting forth the reasons why such claim(s) should not be disallowed or expunged for the reasons set forth in the Objection, including, but not limited to, the specific factual and legal bases upon which the claimant will rely in opposing the Objection;
- (d) all documentation or other evidence of the claim(s), to the extent not included with the proof of claim previously filed with the Bankruptcy Court, upon which the claimant will rely in opposing the Objection at the Hearing;
- (e) the addresses to which the Debtors must return any reply to the response; and
- (f) the name, address, and telephone number of the person (which may be the claimant or his/her/its legal representative) possessing ultimate authority to reconcile, settle, or otherwise resolve the claim on behalf of the claimant.

CLAIMANTS SHOULD NOT CONTACT THE CLERK OF THE COURT TO DISCUSS THE MERITS OF THEIR CLAIMS.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE THAT, IF A CLAIMANT FAILS TO TIMELY FILE AND SERVE A RESPONSE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ABOVE

REQUIREMENTS, SUCH CLAIMANT WILL BE DEEMED TO HAVE CONCURRED WITH
AND CONSENTED TO THE OBJECTION AND THE RELIEF REQUESTED THEREIN,
AND THE DEBTORS WILL PRESENT TO THE BANKRUPTCY COURT WITHOUT
FURTHER NOTICE TO THE CLAIMANT, AN APPROPRIATE ORDER SUSTAINING THE
OBJECTION AND DISALLOWING AND EXPUNGING SUCH CLAIM.
